Senior Teams

The 2012/13 season saw the return of Rupertswood having 5 Senior teams representing the club in the GDCA with the introduction of a team in the one day competition. This was as a result of the increase in willing participants wanting to play cricket from the previous year and allowed for some terrific Father/Son combinations together with some new faces ,junior parents etc who made a great contribution to our club.We had a total of 96 players that represented our senior division overall with 35 of these playing their first senior game for Rupertswood.

Club stalwart, John Lane was appointed Senior Coach and McIntyre 1st XI Captain and led the whole playing group superbly with his usual energy and enthusiasm. John Lane has been reappointed as captain/coach for the 2013/14 season. The club also welcomes back Jay King for next season. John has put together a draft pre-season training schedule that includes sessions at the Sunbury Indoor Centre (\$80 per hour). John will confirm times and book the indoor sessions. Options for a pre-season match were discussed. Mick Carey will ask Jan Juc CC if they are interested for a match on 22/9 preferably down at Jan Juc.

John had a list of training equipment needed that included: Catch it, crazy catch, rebound stump, training balls, net goals. Trevor will chase up some of the equipment. Need to include items for junior training. John & Warren will tidy the nets up so they are ready for pre-season. Numbers were good at training last season, need to maintain them for upcoming season.

Junior Report: Peter Kavanagh gave a report. Peter thanked all of the coaches & support from senior players. President's Report Presented by Mick. A detailed report is attached. Mick thanked the committee, coaches, sponsors & supporters, parents, salesian college and recognised the efforts of the junior and senior teams. Special mention was given to Peter Kavanagh receiving the Club Person of the Year award and Fiona Buckley becoming a life member.

Treasurer's Report: Trevor Harris presented the financial report for last season. Playing Fees up \$200, online rego up, sponsorship up \$720, bank interest up, ball money up \$200, milo up with more kids, merchandise receipts down \$1400. Fundraising was up \$3.5k. Mick Lamb pulled in over \$2k for meat tray raffles. To recognise this effort should change meat tray to Mick Lamb raffle or Lamb tray.

Bar profit increased, senior presentation night receipts were up, trophy costs increased, affiliation fees up \$200, bank charges up \$60 with online fees, Equipment & balls increased \$4300 (Trevor gave a breakdown). Trevor has put in a deposit to buy next year's balls at this year's prices. Club still has funds for a Level 1 coaching course. We have clothing stock to sell this year (Josh has new shorts), but Kooga shirts are not ready yet. New pitch was put on pines oval. Cost of Commemorative matches was up by \$1300 (we hosted 2 matches compared to one in 2011/12). Cleaning

costs were up. Insurance cost down.

Motion put forward by Mick to close Westpac account – seconded by Peter, accepted by committee. Need Mark Inglis to co-sign.

Jay King is organising hoodies and wide brim hats for the club. Quote \$35 for hoodie and \$15 for wide brim. Can add sponsor for small extra cost. Jay and Trevor will visit the manufacturer.
